The will of Abner C. Hobley is recorded in Will Book B, pp. 281-4. It is dated 24 Feb., 1857, and names the following children:

- Martha Mebley
- 5. Samuel Mobley

The will also mentions his wife, Lucy K. Mobley.

C. R. Mobley and Wm. W. Mobley were named executors.

A codicil, dated Oct., 1862, is witnessed by:

A. W. Ellerbee H. J. Winn Simeon Sheppard


The will and codicil were proved Dec. 31, 1863.

A document dated April 3, 1867, names the heirs and distributees under the will of Abner C. Nobley as follows:

Another document relating to the estate of Abner C. Nobley and recorded in Manutes of Frebate Court, Book F, p. 460, under date Sept. 24, 1869, mentions E. R. Coleman as oustedian of the minors, Mary J. and A. C. Nobley. "The Court does not know the names of the infant heirs of Mary A. Heath; their father is their custodian."

It is obvious from the above dates that neither of these wives of Abner C. Nobler was the mother of Sarah E. Bates.

The mother of Sarah E. (Mobley) Bates must have been Ann, the first wife of Abmer C. Mebley. I have not found a record of their marriage, mer of her surname. She signed a deed as wife of A. C. Mebley in 1832, and another in 1845, both in Dallas Co. See Deed Book C, p. 124, and Daed Book L, p. 315.




