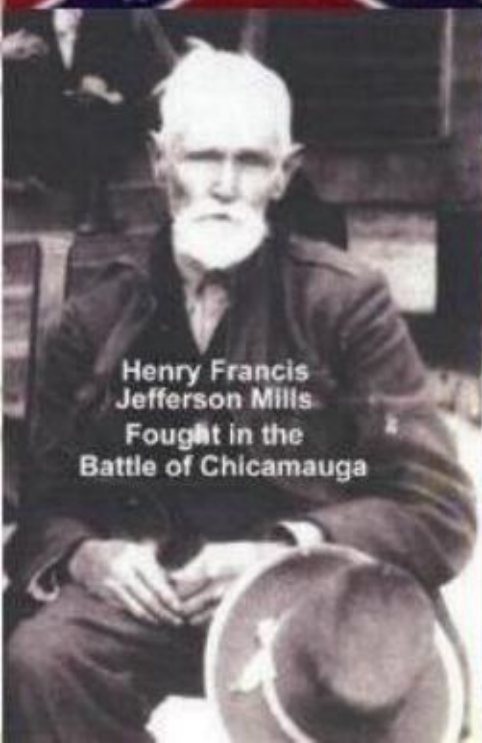


# Henry Francis Jefferson Mills

Henry Francis Jefferson Mills fought in the "Civil War". He served in the Confederate Army, as a private in Co. F, 33rd Ala. Regt., called the "Covington Blue & Grays". He was mustered in on March 11, 1862 and was wounded in the "Battle Of Chicamauga". After being wounded he served the remainder of his time as a nurse. Following the war he received a Confederate pension and lived out the remainder of his life in Bullock community which is now in Crenshaw County, Ala. When his time was up in the Army, he was taken to Montgomery, Ala. where he walked home to Bullock, Alabama.
